

## **PRIVACY POLICY**

We recognize that visitors to our site may be concerned about the information they provide to us, and how we treat that information. This Privacy Policy addresses those concerns. We will only share personally identifiable information with third parties when (1) the person submitting the information authorizes us to share it; (2) sharing the information is a necessary operation of the site, for instance, to process a credit card transaction, or (3) we are required to by law. RTSB has no control over or responsibility for the data collection and use practices of third parties that process credit card transactions.

### **Security**

RTSB cares about the safety and security of all online transactions. We use high-grade encryption and the security protocols to communicate with your browser software. This method is the industry standard, which makes it extremely difficult for anyone else to intercept the information you send to us. ### **"Cookies"**

Visitors should be aware that non-personal information and data might be automatically collected by the RTSB website through the use of "Cookies." "Cookies" are small text files a website can use to recognize repeat visitors, facilitate the visitor's ongoing access to and use of the site, allow a site to track usage behavior, and compile aggregate data that will allow for content improvements. Cookies are not programs that come onto a visitor's system and damage files. Generally, cookies work by assigning a unique number to the visitor that has no meaning outside the assigning site. If a visitor does not want information collected through the use of cookies, there is a simple procedure in most browsers that allows the visitor to deny or accept the cookie feature. RTSB uses "cookie" technology only to obtain non-personal information from its online visitors in order to improve visitors' online experience and facilitate their visit within our site.
